

Horseplayer's World Series Qualifiers

When: *Qualifier #1 - Sunday - November 20, 2011*
Qualifier #2 - Saturday - January 14, 2012

Prizes: 1st Place – Horse Player's World Series Entry (Plus Air & Hotel)
2nd Place - \$400
3rd Place - \$200
4th Place - \$100
5th Place - \$ 50

Entry Fee: \$125.00 (\$25 Entry Fee & \$100 Live Bankroll)

Rules:

1. All Players must register prior to 12:00 Noon, on the day of the contest.
2. Registration begins the day prior to the contest from 12:00 PM until closing time that day.
3. Each Player may have a maximum of two (2) entries.
4. The winner will receive an entry into the Horseplayer's World Series to be held at the Orleans Casino on February 23-25, 2012. (Includes Air & Hotel)
5. The entry fee is \$125.00 consisting of a \$25 entry fee and a \$100 "Live Money Bankroll".
6. Players are entitled to keep the ending balance of their "Live Money Bankrolls" which will be available at the conclusion of the contest.
7. All wagers made during this contest are "Live Wagers" and will be made using the Player's "Live Bankroll".
8. Wagers will be limited to Win, Place or Show only. No other types of wagers may be made!
9. Players may wager any portion of their "Live Bankroll" on any Win, Place or Show wager.
10. Players must wager a minimum of \$100 during the course of the contest.
11. Players can begin making contest wagers on the day of the contest beginning with the first race offered by Horsemen's Park that day. The contest ends that day with the final race from whichever Southern California track is running. (Santa Anita or Hollywood Park) No wagers which involve a post time later than Hollywood or Santa Anita's final race will be accepted.
12. Any races offered through the Horsemen's Park tote system during the contest timeframe can be used for contest wagers.
13. No additional money may be added to the original \$100 Bankroll however all money earned from the original bankroll may be wagered.
14. Contest standings will be posted periodically throughout the day.
15. The contest winners will be determined by money won – not number of winners.
16. All wagers will be audited at the conclusion of the contest to verify the winners.
17. In the event of a tie the highest placing will go to the player who has the highest return on his/her investment, i.e., the Players who made the lower dollar amount of wagers to achieve the same balance.
18. All Players must make their selections through the designated contest tellers.
19. Please identify your contest number to the teller and check your ticket to verify that your number and wagers are correct.
20. Please save all of your receipts in case a dispute arises.
21. Points will be awarded based on the actual mutuel payoff. There will be no caps on payoffs.
22. All selections must be made by the entrant and submitted by the entrant.
23. Program numbers must be used for all selections. Entries and fields go as a single interest.
24. If your selection is scratched your wager will be refunded.
25. You must be 19 years of age to participate.
26. Employees of Horsemen's Park will not be eligible.
27. Horsemen's Park reserves the right to cancel the contest for any reason at any time and assumes no liability for any unforeseen occurrence during the contest.
28. Each player agrees to abide by all the published tournament rules. In the event of a dispute, Horsemen's Park will render a decision and the decision of Horsemen's Park management is final.
