## Family Day at the Races featuring Camel & Ostrich Races

(Omaha) Horsemen's Park (6303 Q. Street) will host its annual Family Day at the Races this Sunday, May 26th.

Camel and Ostrich races have been scheduled as special exhibition races to add to the family friendly events at the track.
